
Assignments are lessons or quizzes that have been assigned to you by your teacher.

View Current Assignments for All Classes and Groups

Your current assignments are available on the **Homepage**.

1. In the sidebar on the left, click the **Home** button .

Your current assignments will be displayed in 1 of 3 columns. depending on its status:



1. **Assigned** - Assignments that you have not opened.
2. **In Progress** - Assignments that you have started, but not yet completed.
3. **Completed** - Assignments that you have completed.
 - o Completed assignments will remain in this column until:
 - 7 days past the due date (if the assignment has a due date)
 - The end of the day (11.59 pm) of the assignment start date (if the assignment has no due date)
 - o To view the rest of your completed assignments, you will need to access them through the class space.

Each assignment card contains the following information:



1. **Assignment Title**
2. **Start and Due date** - This indicates when the assignment is started and its due. If the assignment has no due date, "No Due Date" is displayed.
3. **Progress bar** - This indicates your progress on the assignment.


You can click on any **Card** to access the assignment.

View Assignments for a Specific Class or Group

You can view assignments meant for a specific class or group by going to **My Class** or **My Group**.

From the My Class or My Group

1. In the sidebar on the left, click the **Home** button .
2. On the **Homepage**, click on any class or group under **Please Select** on the top right corner of the page.



Note: You will not see My Groups if you are not in any group.

3. In your class, you will see the related assignments.

From the Assignment Search in Homepage

1. In the sidebar on the left, click the **Home** button .

2. On the **Homepage**, Key in the assignment name under **Find Assignment** above the **Completed** heading.

Each assignment contains the following information:

1. **Title** - Assignment Title
2. **Class/Group** - Class / Group Assignment is given
3. **Assignment due dates** - Submission date of the assignment
4. **Last Access date** - The last date and time you have accessed the assignment
5. **Progress bar** - This indicates your progress on the assignment.
